**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES**

1. Did the Board of Education offer the Student a free appropriate public education?
2. If not, is the Student's placement appropriate?
3. If so, is the Student entitled to reimbursement for the expense of his placement?

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The Student submitted a Request for Impartial Special Education Hearing on January 26, 2012. The Hearing Officer was assigned to the case on January 26, 2012. A telephonic prehearing conference was conducted on February 10, 2012. Hearing dates of April 4 and 5, 2012 were scheduled.

On March 26, 2012, Counsel for the Student notified the Hearing Officer that the Student's Request for Due Process Hearing was withdrawn. As a result, the Hearing Officer canceled the hearings.
