**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

A special education hearing in the above-captioned matter was requested by Student's Attorney via letter dated June 18, 2012.<sup>1</sup>

The Request for Hearing identifies the following issues:

1. Should the Board of Education be required to pay for Student's 2012 extended school year program at Glenholme School?
2. Did the Board of Education fail to provide Student with a free, appropriate public education by failing to convene a PPT?

The thirty-day resolution period ends July 18 and the deadline to mail the final decision and order is September 1.

A pre-hearing conference was scheduled for July 9. On July 2, Student's Attorney indicated that the parties resolved the matter and withdrew the Request for Hearing.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

In light of the above facts, the above-captioned case is hereby dismissed.
