FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Was the Student denied a Free Appropriate Public Education in the Least Restrictive Environment during the 2012-2013 school year?
2. Does Student's program for the 2013-2014 school year provide Student with a Free Appropriate Public Education in the Least Restrictive Environment?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY AND SUMMARY:

On August 1, 2013, the New Britain Board of Education received a Request for a Special Education Due Process Hearing. The undersigned hearing officer was appointed on August 2, 2013. A prehearing conference was set for August 13, 2013. On August 12, 2013 Parent withdrew the hearing request.
