ISSUE:

Did the Board provide an appropriate program as a result of the December 2, 2016 Planning and Placement Team meeting?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:


The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on December 12, 2016. The Hearing Officer was appointed on December 13, 2017 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on December 22, 2016. The hearing was scheduled for February 17, 2017. On February 1, 2017, the Parent reported to the Hearing Officer that the parties had settled the dispute and that the Parent was withdrawing the Hearing Request.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED**.

If the local or regional board of education or the unified school district responsible for providing special education for the student requiring special education does not take action on the findings or prescription of the hearing officer within fifteen days after receipt thereof, the State Board of Education shall take appropriate action to enforce the findings or prescription of the hearing officer.

Appeals from the hearing decision of the hearing officer may be made to state or federal court by either party in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-183, Connecticut General Statutes, and Title 20, United States Code 1415(i)(2)(A).
