FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Did the Board offer the Student a free and appropriate public education for the, 2018-19 school year?
2. Should the Board be ordered to place the Student in regular classes at Lincoln Middle School?
3. Is the Board required to fund an independent neuropsychological evaluation?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on February 22, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on February 22, 2019. A Notice for Prehearing Conference was mailed out, and a Prehearing Conference was scheduled for March 15, 2019. The Parent withdrew her Due Process Request for hearing without prejudice on March 15, 2019.
