FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Was the Student denied FAPE by the Hartford Board of Education (Board) from February 2016 through the end of the school year, the 2017-2018 and the 2018-2019 school years?
2. If the Student was denied FAPE, what is the remedy?
3. Is the Student entitled compensatory education and/or to any other relief as deemed appropriate by the Hearing Officer?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parents filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on March 7, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on March 8, 2019. A Prehearing Conference took place on March 14th, where the issues were laid out and hearing dates were set for late April and early May, 2019. The Hearing Officer was notified by counsel for the Parent's on April 5th that they were withdrawing their due process request.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
