FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

1. Whether the Student is eligible under the IDEA?
2. Whether the Parent is entitled to an IEE at public expense?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on May 6, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on the same date. A Prehearing Conference was held on May 17, 2019. The Board filed a motion to dismiss on May 22, 2019, and the Parent filed an opposition on May 31, 2019. On June 14, 2019, the Parent emailed the Hearing Officer and advised that the Due Process Complaint was being withdrawn without prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

In light of the above, the matter is **DISMISSED**.
