**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

**ISSUES:**

1. Did the Board provide FAPE to Student for the two years prior to the filing of the Due Process Complaint?
2. If not, is the Student entitled to compensatory education?

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:**

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on May 10, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on May 15, 2019 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on June 12, 2019 during which Hearing Officer granted leave for Parents to amend the Due Process Complaint. The hearing was scheduled for July 16, 2019. The parties requested an extension of the mailing date of the Final Decision because they were near final written agreement of the issues in dispute. On July 12, 2019 the Parents withdrew the Due Process Complaint with prejudice.

**FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
