ISSUES:

1. Was there a denial of FAPE for the 2017, 2018, 2018-109, and 2019-2020 school years, as well as related ESY?
2. If so, have there been serious procedural violations giving rise to compensatory education?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parents filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on July 8, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on July 11, 2019. A Prehearing Conference was not held. The mailing date of the decision was September 24, 2019. The complaint is dismissed for failure to prosecute.

The matter is **DISMISSED**.
