Transferred Funds:

• <u>Programmatic</u>: Title II, Part A transferred funds take on the requirements of Title I, Part A or Title III.

• Fiscal:

- Public transfer On the "Title I Ranking Schools and Allocating Funds" page, public Title II transferred funds are added to the school district's total Title I allocation before determining the amount of Title I funds to be distributed to the district's schools.*
 - On the Title II public budget and budget narrative, transferred funds are identified and explained in the object code "914" line item.
- Private transfer Transferred funds are identified and explained on the Title II private budget and budget narrative in the object code "914" line item.
