8/7/37 About 20 trees av. ht. 5 ft. gravelly yellow clay soil. Good drainage. 1 1/2 to 3' current growth. Grass cover. A few trees bearing. Seeds 12 - 354 old re-plantments.
1/5/39 - about 1/3 dead + replaced in 1938. Some nuts last season.
