Remarks:

3/29/35 - Trees planted on farm of D. L. Yarbrough, 3 mi. east of Prattville. 2 trees bore fruit last fall; tallest tree at end of 3rd year 11 ft, others 6 to 10 ft. Nuts vary dry, but of nice size.

8/26/36 First nuts of the year rec'd from these trees this date. Seven unattractive nuts, clean poorly, taste corny, kernel pale yellow. Probably from M J trees. Nuts have appearance of Korean variety of crenata. F.P. 716.

8/27/36 Sends 5 nuts from his earliest clivine, ripening about Aug 1. Nuts very attractive mahogany red, shiny. Kernel yellow, corny, clean fair. about 95 to lb. F.P. 716A.

8/7/37 See chart and notes in file. Series 15 mollis to replace.
