1938-- 12 MBH C. mollisima

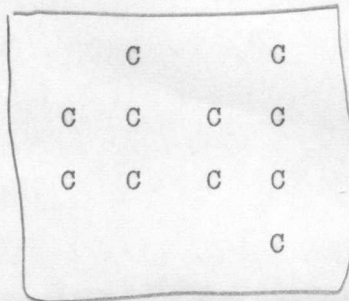
Directions to reach:

From square in Nashville cross bridge, proceed to first red light. Turn left and follow 1st. st. to C. H. Smith's filling station. Turn left onto Whites Creek pike. Go about 4 miles. House of stone on the left. ~~almost~~ ~~xxxxxxfromxxxx~~ a brick house is about 75 yards from it on the same side.
