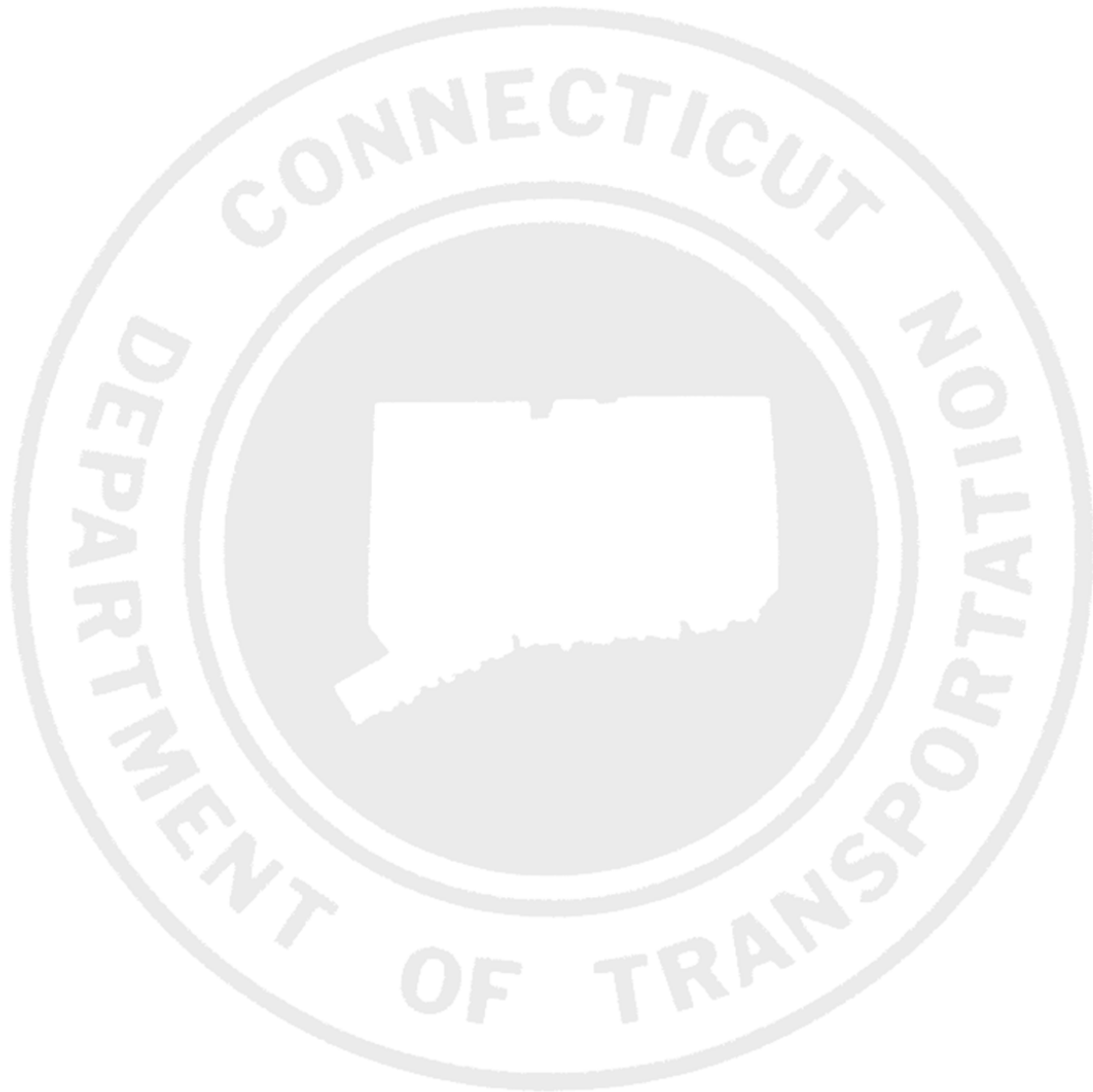

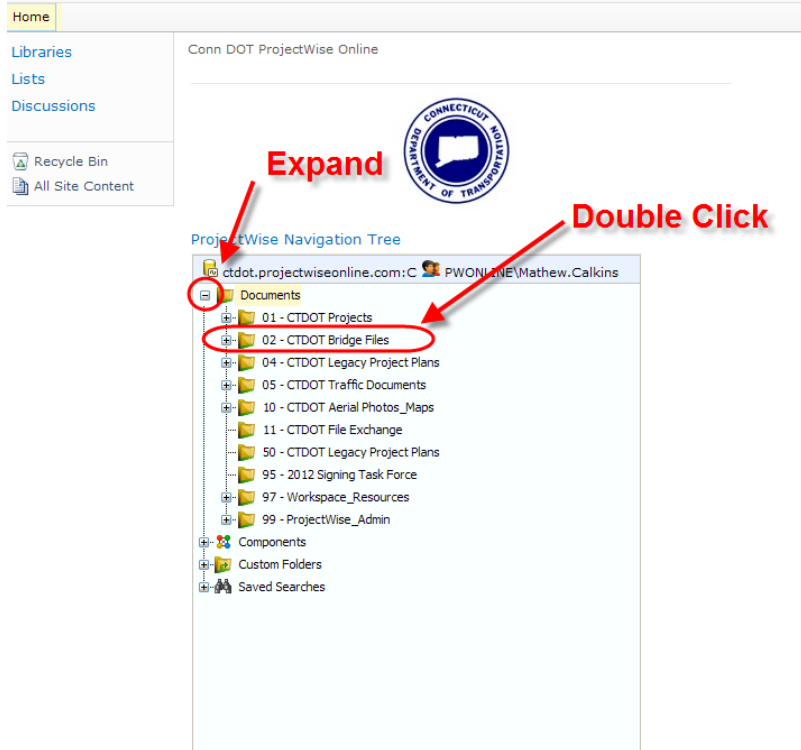

# Sections 1 Bridge Files

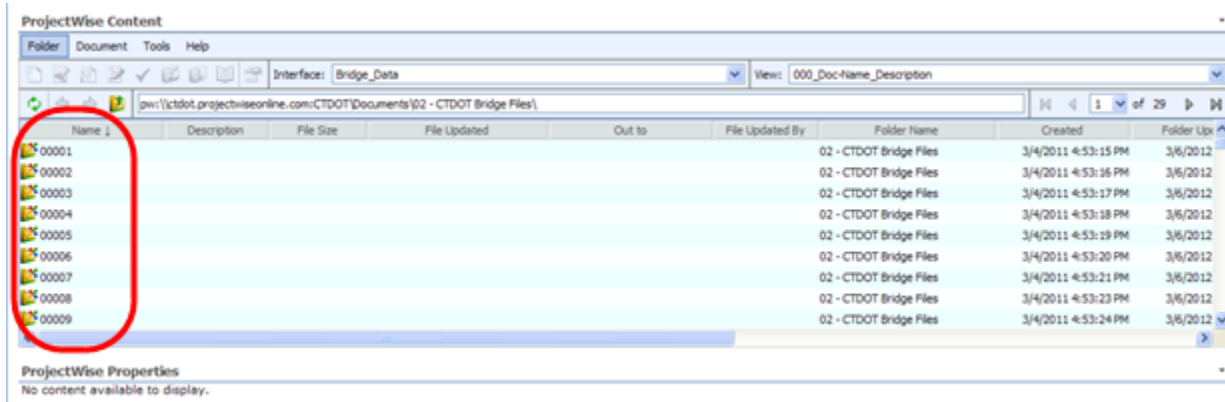
## 1.1 Accessing the Bridge Folders

The following is shown using Projectwise Thin Client. Users can also access the Bridge files using Thick client if it is installed on their computer.

1. Access Projectwise Thin Client using the following link: <https://ctdot.projectwiseonline.com>.
2. Enter your Projectwise user name and password.
3. On the left side of the screen double click on the *Documents>02 – CTDOT Bridge Files* folder.

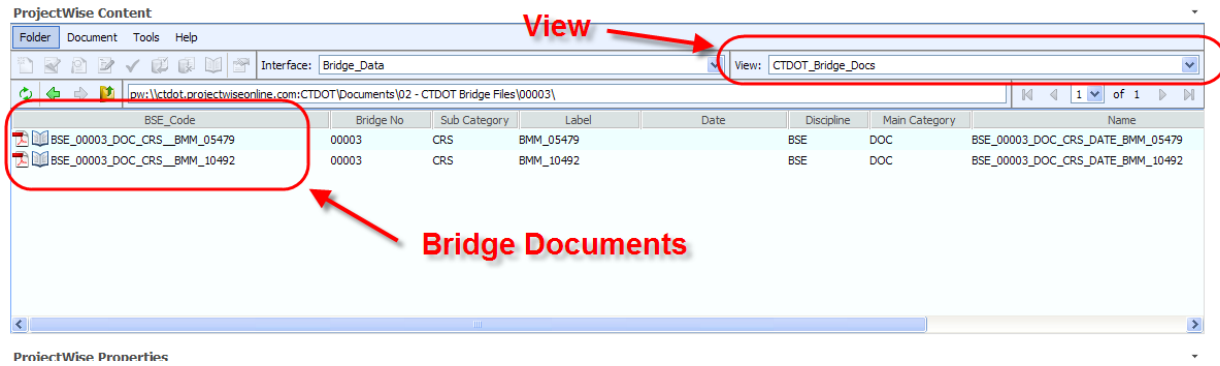


4. Now on the right side of the screen you will see all the bridge folders. Each bridge has its own folder, by bridge #.



## 1.2 Viewing a Bridge Document

1. Find the bridge you are looking for and double click on its folder, the folder will open up and you will see all the bridge documents. Make sure the view is as shown below.



2. Double click on a file to open it.

### 1.3 Downloading Bridge Documents

1. If you would like to save a copy of a file(s) to your computer, select a document(s), right click on the document(s) and select *Download*. Then select the place on your computer where you would like to download this file to.
