TO: CONSULTING ENGINEERS


The subject Section 6.01 and M.03 revisions have been incorporated into the January 2014 Supplemental Specifications to Form 816. *They are available on the Department of Transportation website.*

While these Sections were being used as special provisions, a General Note ("Concrete Note") was prescribed to be placed on the plans immediately below the Allowable Design Stresses for Concrete.

Projects with FDP dates after March 25, 2014 will reference the January 2014 Supplements and the Special Provisions will no longer be required. Also, the "Concrete Note" to be included now will be as follows:

"THE SPECIFIED CONCRETE STRENGTH USED IN DESIGN, F'_c , OF THE CONCRETE COMPONENTS IS NOTED ABOVE. THE MINIMUM COMPRESSIVE STRENGTH OF THE CONCRETE IN THE CONSTRUCTED COMPONENTS SHALL CONFORM TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF 'SECTION 6.01 CONCRETE FOR STRUCTURES'."
