AUTHORITY

By application 1910-I-111-L, filed with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department") on October 8, 2019, Litchfield County Livery L.L.C. (hereinafter "applicant"), seeks approval to register its Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration authority, as authorized and contained in certificate number MC-747927-C, issued on November 8, 2012. The applicant submitted the requisite Criminal Conviction Information Report, conducted in accordance with Section 29-17a of the Connecticut General Statutes.

After consideration by the Department, the instant application is hereby approved in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-102(b), and Livery Permit Number 3678 is issued to Litchfield County Livery L.L.C. in the following form:

LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 3678
FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN INTERSTATE LIVERY SERVICE

Litchfield County Livery L.L.C is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number MC-747927-C.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/ or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.**

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
