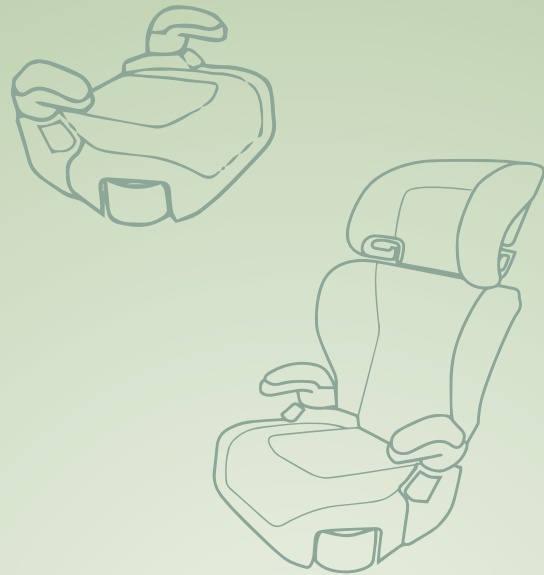




Connecticut Child Restraint Law

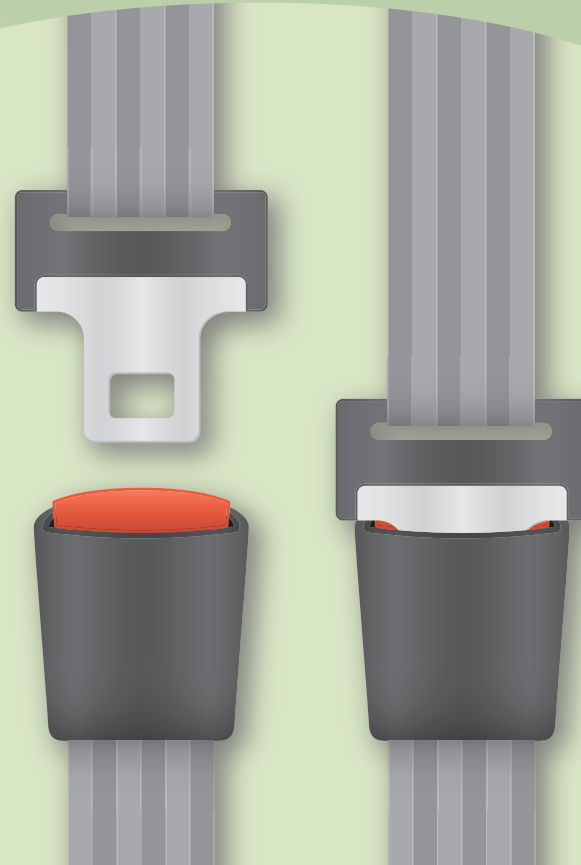
Effective: October 1, 2017

Children 8 years of age or older and weighing 60 lbs. or more can use a safety belt or a booster seat.



*These seats **must** be used with a lap and shoulder belt.*

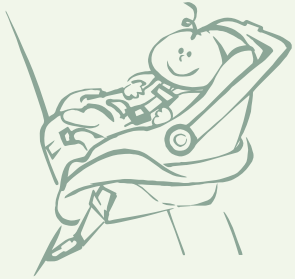
Children learn what they see. Buckle up every time you ride in the car!



Failure to follow the law will subject you to a ticket/citation and an educational class.



Children under 2 years old or weighing less than 30 lbs. **must** ride in a rear facing car seat.



This could be either a rear-facing-only car seat



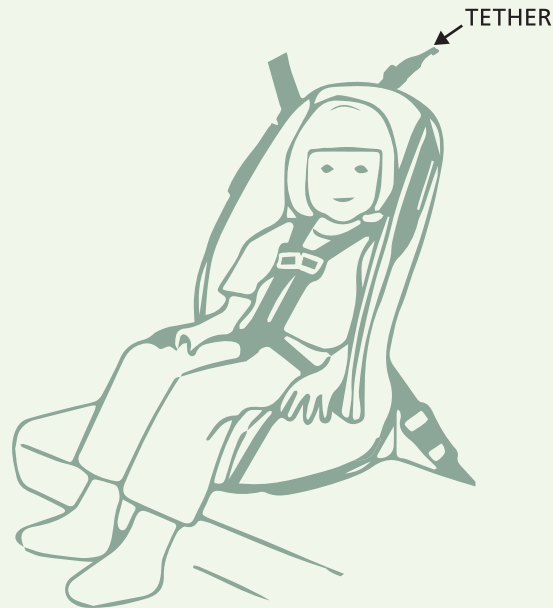
Or a rear facing convertible seat with a 5-point harness



Do not place a rear facing car seat in the front seat with an active air bag!

Children 2 years of age to 5 years of age or weighing less than 40 lbs. **must** use a child restraint that has a 5-point harness.

Children 5 – 8 years of age or weighing between 40 – 60 lbs. **must** use a booster seat or a five point harness.
